

1. **Midmark 417 surgical table/chair.** This one is heavy duty and the workhorse of podiatry offices. It is in very good shape. I have matching Dr's stool. Also has attachment for "shoe tray". Professional resellers sites often ask up to 5 K for chair alone. For the chair and matching D's stool. **\$2900**
2. **2 Electric Podiatry/Spa chairs.** They move in all directions and lie flat. Only 2 years old, lightly used. \$2400 new, asking *\$1700 with matching stool.*
3. **2 Midmark 425 hydraulic stools** (the contoured ones). Top of the line for comfort! Sounds crazy, but on eBay, they are asking over \$1,000. Google it!!! *Each \$220.*
4. **2 Non Midmark hydraulic stools with back.** *\$60 each.*
5. **Tuttnauer #1730 autoclave.** Almost brand new, hardly used. New \$2200, asking *\$1400.*
6. **Erchonia Lunula Nail Laser.** Cool frequency wave length, no heat. Patients loved it. Best thing is that after you push the button, the patient does not have to be attended to by you or staff. These are motivated patients that will also buy antifungal products. I will go over protocols with you. No used ones can be found on the internet! *\$12,000.*
7. **Sonicare 600 ultrasound and printer.** It is an analog one, but Medicare pays same for analog as digit scans. Great for injection under imaging. On web they are asking up over \$1,000 for machine and almost \$1,000 for the printer, which I think I excessive. *\$1,000 for both.*
8. **Ellman Surgitron,** for radiofrequency surgery, which I used to replace my laser for matrixectomies (patients were impressed by technology) and lesion removals. Hand piece can be sterilized for use in surgery. Can attach blade and make incision with coagulation. There are YouTube videos. Used ones on the web are more than 2 K. I have two of them, but one has sort in grounding pad (which can probably can be repaired), which is \$200 on the web. *Complete one:*

\$900. One with short in pad \$650. Large set of probes, for different procedures, some new \$75.

9. **Stryker cast saw.** The original heavy duty saw. Shock Wave is a proven modality that has had literally thousands of papers written about its efficacy. Always good to have an extra one, as they sometimes fail and you have a cast half off. With extra blade, \$200.00
10. **Dolor Clast, Radial Shock Wave Machine.** This machine, manufactured in Switzerland, is considered the gold standard. Also, the one that probably has the most associated published papers. Terrific modality, that patients love. There is no need for anesthesia. I can explain to you how to present it to patients. I also have an extra hand piece that cost \$2500 new. The machine was \$20,000 new. I will sell both for \$10,000
11. **File Stream brand, nail grinder with vacuum.** No need to breath in nail dust. New was \$1700. Now \$700
12. **Osada Pedo 30W surgical drill.** Great condition. Perfect for office procedures, like ostectomies. Can even be used for osteotomies. Rare to find used ones, which can be listed at over 3K. This one is with burs and accessories \$1,000.
13. **Mayo Stand**, perfect condition. Great for office procedures. Also to block Patient's view. \$80
14. **33 surgical steel/podiatry instruments**, all high quality, instruments, nail splitters (4) or "English nail anvils", mayo and iris scissors, iris and Kelly hemostats, forceps, 312 handles, rasps and more. Most cost 50 to \$100. ***Wish to sell all together at \$825 /*** which is \$25 apiece. If serous about them, I will list individually. Threw a couple of little things in also.
15. **Boxes of medical odds and ends**, like plaster, blades, syringes, needles, gauze, red bags, autoclave wrap papers and much more. Probably over \$700new. \$100
16. **Antifungal products for retail sale**, only sold in doctor's office. Staff does the selling after you make the suggestion. 34 Blaine lab

Terpenicol for nails (we were selling for \$22), 4 Marlinz Tolcyen shoe spray (we were selling for \$25), 7 Marlinz skin cream (we were selling for \$29), 8 Fungifoam tubes (we were selling for \$30), 4 Fortinia powder spray (we sold for \$23). If patients were serious about fungal care, we had antifungal products for skin, nails and shoes sprays. Average cash cost to patient was over \$80. Retail cost (to the patient) of supplies is \$1383. *Buy all for \$500.*

17. **Dr. Remedy Enriched Nail Care Products.** The best products for nail health with antifungal properties. Not sold in stores and prices on internet do not under cut retail prices! Staff will have fun selling all the colors. 2 acrylic stands (were \$35 each), 105 X polishes (many colors), 19 X "2 in 1", 9 X restore ridge repair, 2 X hydration nail moisturizers. Our cost was \$1453, profit retail cost \$3,516. 60% of our cost: \$872, plus acrylic stands and 25 open demonstrator polish bottles for free.
18. **Diabetic shoes**, 492 pairs of Apex. All Medicare approved. Most cost me 70-\$75 (about 35,670). Wish to sell all together a, *\$9840 (\$20/pair)*. Yes, that is a lot of inventory, but worth it when you realize *Medicare pays \$155.60* for each pair provided. I can provide inventory list with sizes and styles. Also, we never got denied by Medicare and we can help you.
19. **Brother 3 in one MFC-L2710DW Printer** and extra ink cartridge. Perfect for heavy duty office work. *\$100*
20. A number of **P.O shoes and ankle braces**. They are in box under many boxes, if serous, I will get them out for exact inventory. Darby P.O. shoe (\$7): Darby Orthowedge (\$10), Aircast ankles braces (\$15-20), and cloth ankle braces (\$5).
21. **Activa MD 1000 10 sheet cross-cut shredder.** *\$25*
22. **Powerstep arch slides X 20.** For those who don't always want or need an orthotic. Retails for 65-\$70 dollars. Buy all 20 for *\$400 (\$20/pair)*.
23. Articulated Foot model (not real bone) Great to aid in explaining pathology to patient. *\$15.*

24. MHT model 750 heat gun. Heavy duty, used for adjustments to orthotics and braces. \$75.

25. Light-Tech 375 head lamp with flip up magnifier. Plug in with battery available. From web site: *“A unique multitask instrument to enhance vision, unobtrusive 2-ounce illuminator provides 10 watts of intense halogen light @ 3250°k to emulate the color rendition of natural white light, optics are precision ground and polished optical glass. Use with or without glasses, visor pivots up when not needed.”* \$75.
